**V. DISCUSSION / APPROVAL OF UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (USDA) LOAN AND GRANT RESOLUTION FOR THE PURCHASE OF A BACKHOE FOR THE WATER DEPARTMENT**

**NOTE:** Loan will be in the amount of \$112,300, interest rate of 3.75% for 8 years. USDA is contributing \$19,800 and this portion is a grant and does not have to be paid back.

**NOTE:** The original allocated amount is \$1,472,785.94 so the project cost overrun budget is \$147,278.59. The overrun budget does not require any local match money.
